The class meets monthly on a designated Thursday. It typically begins at 7:45 a.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. with lunch provided. The time may vary depending on the events scheduled for the day.

The year will begin with a 2-day opening retreat and ropes course. Two or three days will be allocated for a trip to Austin to study the state government. During the second half of the year, the class will spend 2 days hosting the Angelina County Science & Tech Fair. Class members are responsible for attending on their own the following:

- ◆ Applicants must be 21 years of age or older.

- ◆ Applicant must obtain approval from CEO or Senior Executive where applicant works.
- ◆ Must pay tuition of \$975* in full upon acceptance to the class.
